Christmas (Lessons from John 1.1).

Parchment. 1 folio (foliated "x" in the upper center margin of the recto). 301 x 237 mm (written space 220 x 165 mm). 2 columns. 28 lines. Ruled in ink. Single vertical bounding lines.

Written in two sizes of gothic script, the small a littera textualis and the large a textualis formata. 1 10-line initial "I" is in red and is set apart from the text. 1- and 2-line initials are in red and are not set apart from the text. Other 1-line initials are in black highlighted with red. Rubrics are written in red in the same script as the text. The first letter after the initial of the sequence and the lesson from John is a capital written in black and highlighted with red. The foliation is written in red. Punctuation consists of the punctus and the punctus elevatus. Hyphenation is in the same ink as the text.

The fragment was used in the binding of a volume measuring at least 301 x 210 mm.
