Common of a Martyr not a Bishop. The lessons are from Isaiah 43.1-5, Sirach 39.6-13, Wisdom 10.10-14, Wisdom 4.7-15 and Sirach 14.22, 15.3.

Parchment. 2 folios (fol. 2 is foliated "ccxi" in the center of the upper margin of the recto). 268 x 270 mm (written space originally ca. 245 x 176 mm). 2 columns. 32 lines remaining of an original ca. 34. Ruled in ink. Single vertical bounding lines.

Written in gothic script (*littera textualis*). 1- and 2-line initials alternate red and blue and are not set apart from the text. Other 1-line initials are in brown highlighted with red. Rubrics are written in red in the same script as the text. Foliation is written in red. Punctuation consists of the punctus. Hyphenation is in the same ink as the text.

The bifolium was used in the binding of a volume measuring ca. 215 x 150 mm. There are illegible traces of a title or shelf number from the spine of the binding.
