Augustine, In Iohannis evangelium tractatus

The text of the tractates in these leaves is abbreviated, and there is no separation between them, suggesting that this may be an epitome of the text or a homily.

Tractatus 69.3.7-19; R. Willems, 501. The lower margin has been trimmed with loss of text.

Parchment (both leaves stained and torn from use in a binding). 2 folios. 206 x 160 mm (written space originally ca. 273 x 178 mm). 2 columns. 20 lines remaining of original ca. 34.

Dry-point ruling on the hair side. Single vertical bounding lines.

Written in Caroline minuscule. 1-line initials are in brown uncials, not set apart from the

text. Punctuation consists of the punctus, punctus elevatus and the punctus interrogativus.
Hyphenation by first hand.

Both fragments were used as pastedowns in the binding of a volume measuring ca. 206 x 155 mm. The inscription "RH" is written on fol. 1r in purple ink.

Fol. 1 was formerly Zinniker 173B; fol. 2 was Beinecke MS 482.35, Zinniker 110.
