Psalm 93.18 - 100.4. A contemporary hand has added Glorias with neumes to the ends of Psalms 93, 96 and 98. A later hand has added marginalia next to Psalms 96 and 97 in a fourteenth-century cursive gothic script. The inner column has been trimmed with loss of text.

Parchment (verso badly stained). 1 folio. 345 x 205 mm (written space originally ca. 305 x 190 mm). 2 columns. 34 lines.

Written in late Caroline minuscule. 2- to 4-line initials at the beginning of psalms are in red uncials or capitals and are not set apart from the text. 1-line initials at the beginning of verses are in red and are not set apart from text. The first word of each psalm is written in rustic capitals. Punctuation consists of the punctus. The psalms are not written in verse.

The fragment was used as the cover on a binding measuring ca. 305 x 190 mm and has an inscription (mostly illegible) with the years "1580," "1581," and "1582."
