Sts. Simon and Jude (28 October); the text is an excerpt from the Passio SS. Simonis et Iudae (BHL 7750); Mombricitus, 534.23-42. The leaf has been cut in half and one line is missing from the middle; only the inner column remains.

f. 1vb [Inc: Apud prouinciam Retiam in ciuitate Augusta Narcissus episcopus ...
 uulneri]//bus elephantie corpore toto plenus ... princeps noster ab eo qui crucifixus//

St. Narcissus (29 October); the text is an excerpt from the Conversio et Passio S. Aefrae (BHL 108); MGH Script.Rer.Merov. III.58.8-24. The leaf has been cut in half and one line is missing from the middle; only the inner column remains.

Parchment. 1 folio. Each fragment measures 200 x 135 mm; the original leaf measured ca. 435 x ca. 260 mm (written space originally ca. 325 x 240 mm). 1 (inner) of 2 columns remaining. 29 of 30 lines remaining. Ruled in ink; single vertical bounding lines.

Written in late Caroline minuscule. 1-line initials in red are written on the vertical bounding line when they occur at the beginning of a line. Other 1-line initials are in brown and are not set apart from the text. Punctuation consists of the punctus, punctus elevatus and punctus interrogativus. Hyphenation is in the same ink as the text.

The pieces were used as pastedowns in the binding of a volume measuring ca. 200 x 135

mm.
