Psalm 36.20 - 36.

Parchment (tear in outer and lower margin repaired with gold and pale red thread). 1 folio. 330 x 213 mm (written space 255 x 140 mm). 1 column. 21 lines. Ruled in lead; double vertical bounding lines. Prickings in upper, lower and outer margins.

Written in large late Caroline minuscule. 1-line initials of each verse are in orange square capitals, with round forms of D and E, and are set apart from text between the vertical bounding lines. Punctuation consists of the punctus and punctus elevatus.

The leaf was used in the binding of a volume measuring ca. 330 x 203 mm.
