Written in gothic script (littera textualis), above top line. 3-line initial "B" ("Benedictus") is in red with blue and red penwork and is written on the inner vertical bounding line. 1-line initials at the beginning of verses are in red uncials and are not set apart from the text. Line dividers are in red. Punctuation consists of the punctus.

This fragment was used as a wrapper for a volume measuring ca. 123 x 72 mm.
