Written in early gothic script, below the top line. 2-line initials at the beginning of each mass and 1-line initials for other prayers are in red and are written on the vertical bounding line. Rubrics are written in red in the same script as the text, with occasional use of uncial or rustic capital forms. Punctuation consists of the punctus. Hyphenation is in the same ink as the text.

The fragment was used as the wrapper for a copy of Abraham Gorlaeus's *Dactyliothea* that measured ca. 190 x 145 mm. The partially damaged inscription "Gorl'i Dactyliothea" is written on the spine.
