Hildebert of Le Mans, Sermones de tempore, Sermon 11 (On Tit. 3.5; Christmas; 25 December); PL 171.392-4. The lower margin has been trimmed with the loss of two lines of text.

Unidentified sermon on John the Evangelist (27 December). The lower margin has been trimmed with the loss of two lines of text.

Unidentified sermon on the Circumcision (1 January). The lower margin has been trimmed with the loss of two lines of text.

Parchment. 1 folio. 195 x 175 mm (written space originally ca. 187 x 150 mm). 2 columns. 31 lines remaining of an original 33. Ruled in ink. Single vertical bounding lines.

Written in an informal gothic script (approaching a *littera textualis currens*). Spaces have been left at the beginning of the homilies for 2-line initials, not set apart from the text, but they have not been added. 1-line initials are in brown and are not set apart from the text. Punctuation consists of the punctus. A contemporary hand has made some corrections to the text in a darker ink.

The fragment was used as a pastedown in the binding of a volume measuring at least 175 x 195 mm. A modern hand has written the number "9" in pencil in the upper left corner of the recto.
