Aldricus, who is named in line 7, was bishop of Trento from 1232 to 1247; see C. Eubel, Hierarchia Catholica Medii Aevi (Regensburg, 1913), 1:497.

Notarial redaction of a judgement emanating from the podesta of Trento Riprandus Otonis Rici by order of Bishop Aldricus of Trento concerning a controversy between Maius filius quondam Romedii and Niger filius Gonterii over easement to the stable of Maius (which Niger has obstructed with a hedge). On the verso the word "nichil" and the year "1233" are written in contemporary hands.

Written in notarial script by Rolandinus. At the opening of the document there is a design in brown ink resembling a chalice. A cross stands above the entire document. The initial "E" of the notary's signature is a 2-line square-shaped capital in black ink, decorated with dots and not set apart from the text (his signum tabellionis). Punctuation consists of the punctus and, at the end of the document, the punctus versus.
