Rubrics are written in red in the same script as the text. Punctuation consists of the punctus. Hyphenation is in the same ink as the text. Foliation from the fifteenth century is in upper margin of the recto: "CLXXI".

The fragment was used as the binding of a volume measuring ca. 210 x 150 mm.
