Parchment (fols. 1r and 2v are damaged from use in a binding; pieces of paper and wood are still
attached to them). 2 folios. Fol. 1 measures 310 x 208 mm; fol. 2 measures 310 x 188 mm
(written space 217 x 160 mm). 2 columns. 20 lines. Ruled in ink. Single vertical and double
horizontal bounding lines.

Written in two sizes of gothic script (littera textualis formata) with a larger script for the

lessons and prayers and a smaller script for the chants. There are spaces for initials and rubrics, but none have been added except for the lengthy rubric on fol. 2v. 1-line capitals within lessons are black, not set apart from the text, and adorned with black penwork. Punctuation is very rare and consists of the punctus. Hyphenation is in the same ink as the text. Accents were added by a later hand.
