Contract for sale of property by Bernardino a Buscho to the monastery of St.

Mark in Trent. The notary is Simon, son of Girardus Mirara(?). Docket on verso.

Dry-point ruling.

Written in Italian notarial minuscule. The document begins with a 7-line initial "I" in brown, not set apart from the text. 1-line initials within the text are in brown and are not set apart from the text. Punctuation consists of the colon. Hyphenation is in the same ink as the text.

In the upper left corner of the verso there are traces of red ink, suggesting that there was once a number here similar to those on MSS 482.139 and 482.141.
