Leviticus 22.32 - 23.3. Only the bottom five lines of the leaf remain.

f. 1rb      //pro peccato. duosque agnos anniculos hostias pacificorum ... Legitimum  
sempiternum erit in cunctis//

Leviticus 23.19-21. Only the bottom six lines of the leaf remain.

f. 1va      //mensis septimi. quando ... et ramos ligni den//[sarum]

Leviticus 23.39-40. Only the bottom six lines of the leaf remain.

f. 1vb      [male]//dixerit deo suo portabit ... nomen domini [morte m]oria//[tur]

Leviticus 24.15-16. Only the bottom five lines of the leaf remain.

Parchment. 1 folio. 110 x 295 mm (written space originally ca. 375 x 230 mm.). 2 columns. 5-6 lines remaining of original ca. 45. Dry-point ruling. Double vertical bounding lines surround both columns.

Written in late Caroline minuscule. Punctuation consists of the punctus and punctus elevatus. Accents are in the same ink as the text. Chap. 23 begins with the number "lxxvi" in

red.

The fragment was used in the binding of a volume measuring ca. 265 mm in height. A modern hand has written "T41" in pencil in the lower left corner of the recto.
