Parchment. 2 folios (bifolium). 146 x 107 mm (written space 110 x 75 mm). 1 column. 16 lines. Dry-point ruling on the hair side. Double vertical and single horizontal bounding lines. Prickings in outer, upper and lower margins.

Written in Caroline minuscule. 1-line initials are in red square capitals, with round E and enlarged minuscule n, and are set apart from the text between double bounding lines; one initial between double bounding lines is in brown. Rubrics are written in red minuscule. Punctuation consists of the punctus and punctus elevatus.

The bifolium was formerly used as the wrapper of a volume measuring ca. 123 x 75 mm. On the spine is written "Causus Conscientiae Ad(am) Burghaber. s.j." Numerous editions of this work from 1654-1773 are cited in Augustin de Backer, *Biblioteque ecrivains de la Compagnie de Jesus--Bibliographie*, vol. 2, ed. Carlos Sommervogel (Brussels, 1890, rpt. Louvain, 1960), 387, chap. 11.
