lines. Dry-point ruling (very faint). Double vertical bounding lines.

Written in two sizes of late Caroline script, with a larger script for the lessons and prayers
and a smaller script for the chants. 1- and 2-line initials are in red square capitals, with round D,
and are set apart from the text when they occur at the beginning of a line. Other 1-line initials
are in brown rustic capitals. Rubrics are written in red minuscule, with occasional rustic capital
and uncial forms. Punctuation consists of the punctus and the punctus elevatus. Hyphenation
and accents are in the same ink as the text. Interlinear neumes are in the St. Gall style.

The bifolium was used as a wrapper of a volume measuring ca. 323 x 120 mm and has
the inscription "Mein Ungect(?) Register Anno 1569".
