Written in late Caroline minuscule. 3-line initial "D" ("Domine") is in red with blue flourishes and is not set apart from the text. 1-line initials are in red square capitals, with round E, and are not set apart from the text. Rubrics are written in red rustic capitals. Punctuation consists of the punctus and the punctus versus. Hyphenation is in the same ink as the text.
