2. Alexander episcopus, servus servorum Dei, dilectis filiis archidiacono, preposito et canonacis [*sic*] Senensibus salutem et apostolicam benedictionem. Constitutus in presentia nostra dilectus filius noster G. ... Datum Tusculani Non. Maii [in dorso: Badia Passignano 7 Mag. 1164].

Pope Alexander III (1159-1181) to the archdeacon, provost and canons of Siena: grants permission to the parishioners of Pugna to enter the church of Alfiano on holidays and to choose their sepulture in that church against possible opposition from the prior of Alfiano. 3. In Christi nomine notitia. Breve recordationis et future ostensionis ad memoriam habendam vel retinendam imposterum, qualiter actum est in civitate Pistoensi in Porta Guidi, in claustro Sancti Mercurialis, ... Et sunt anni Domini M C LXVI, XIII Kal. Ianuarii, indictione XV.

Concession by way of *livellum* of a piece of land by Maximilla, abbess of the abbey of San Mercuriale in Pistoia, to the brothers Paganellus and Iucta quondam Baldini Guidori. Pistoia, Porta Guidi, abbey of San Mercuriale, 19 Dec. 1166. Written and signed by the imperial notary Guido.

4. In nomine Domini nostri Ihesu Christi Dei eterni. Anno a Nativitate Domini nostri Ihesu Christi M C LXIII, VI Id. Martii, indictione XI ... Actum in civitate Pistoensi in Porta Guidi.

Sale of land by Treguanus quondam Falconcelli to his brother Bellidronius. Pistoia, Porta Guidi, 10 March 1163. Written and signed by the notary Belchitus.

5. In Christi nomine notitia. Breve recordationis et future ostensionis ad memoriam habendam vel retinendam imposterum qualiter actum est in civitate Pistoensi in Porta Guidi ... Et sunt anni Domini M C LXVI, VII Idus Novembris, indictione XV.

Rental agreement between Paulus quondam Uscelle and his wife Ugolina quondam Moronis on the one side, and Soldanellus quondam Pieri and his wife Cieca quondam Punciutri on the other. Pistoia, Porta Guidi, 7 Nov. 1166. Written and signed by the imperial notary Guido.

6. In Christi nomine. Breve recordationis tenimenti qualiter factum est in Castello de Serra ...
Actum in anno Domini millesimo C^o sexagesimo quarto, in mense Ianuarii, indictione XII.

Rental agreement between the brothers Gerardus and Uguiccione quondam Burnecti Rothi on the one side, and the priest Gerardus, plebanus and custos plebis of the church of San Andrea di Furfalo, on the other. La Serra, Jan. 1164. Written and signed by the papal notary Tignosus.

7. In nomine sancte et individue Trinitatis. Sunt anni Domini M C LXIII, III Kal.
Septembris, indictione XII ... Actum est in civitate Pistoïensi in Porta Lucese.

Sale of land by Ranuccinus quondam Pieri and his wife Claritia quondam Bakianelli to the priest Guido on behalf of San Bartolomeo de Ospitale de Prato Veteri. Pistoia, Porta Lucchese, 30 August 1164. Written and signed by the imperial notary Guido.

Parchment, 7 charters of various sizes (140 x 100 mm. to 440 x 145 mm.), mostly of a trapezium shape.

Copied by various hands in Pregothisc documentary script.

Among the notarial signs the one of Tignosus (art. 6) is noticeable: a knight in coat of mail, with raised sword.
